Open House & Schedule Changes

New Cell Phone Policy 2019-2020

Cell phones will not be allowed in the classroom, including those electronic devices in the form of watches, iPods, etc. during the school day and may only be accessible during hall passing and lunch periods in the cafeteria. This is not a right; it is a privilege and can be taken away at any time. Students must store all electronic devices, including cell phones, in their lockers at all times, except those mentioned above (hall passing and lunch). If an electronic device goes off during class, or if the electronic device is visible during a classroom period, the student will be subject to disciplinary action. Furthermore, Headphones will not be allowed or worn in the hallways or classrooms. Headphones may be worn and used during lunch ONLY.
