Bus Policy:

Parents must be home and visible to the Bus Driver for any child in K-3rd grade(s), or be with an older sibling in order for the driver to let the students off the bus during drop off. Otherwise, students will be returned to the school at the end of the route. Students brought back to the school will be checked-in to Latchkey and charged accordingly . Please type your name as signing that you agree to follow the policy.

Walker Policy:

Per our Student Code of Conduct*, students may only sign themselves out as a walker if they are 4th-6th grade. (*Page 5) As part of this distinction, if a 4th-6th student is responsible for signing out younger siblings/relatives they must be present for the younger siblings to still be signed out as walkers.

*****If the 4th-6th student is absent or unavailable due to sports or other after school events, the younger siblings/relatives would require parent pick up. An end of day change note will need to be sent in for the younger students. A "Walker Contract" will be sent home to families who indicate their children will be walkers for the 22-23 school year.

School doors open at 7:35 am. School releases at 2:40 pm. Pickup students MUST be signed out by a parent, guardian or person(s) on student pickup list.
