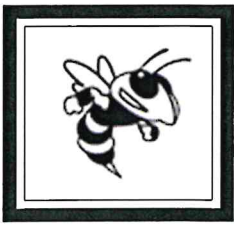

Important **SENIOR** Information

Thursday, May 9th: INTERFAITH BACCALAUREATE SERVICE

Held in the high school gym at 7:00 p.m. Students will be invited if they have earned honors to be announced this evening, however all seniors are welcome to attend to support and cheer on their classmates! Students should wear graduation gowns.

Wednesday, May 15: SENIOR EXIT INTERVIEWS

Seniors will be assigned a time to report to school to interview; the rest of the day, they are excused. Students should wear professional interview clothing.

Thursday, May 16: SENIORS' LAST SCHOOL DAY

Be sure to take home all of your belongings. Once dismissed, students will not be allowed to reenter the building during the school day.

Friday, May 17: GRADUATION REHEARSAL

You must attend this mandatory rehearsal if you plan to participate in graduation! Plan ahead as you make appointments, begin your summer jobs, etc.! Time to be announced, but it will be in the morning. *Students MUST complete any Saturday School requirements in order to participate in the graduation ceremony.*

All seniors will meet in the auditorium at 1:30 p.m. Graduation begins at 2:00 p.m.

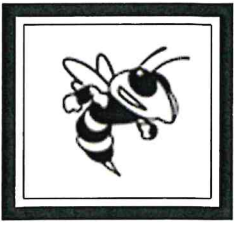
All seniors **MUST** wear caps and gowns, and follow this suggested dress code:

Scholarships Announced on Honors Night:

The only way scholarships will be announced is if they are reported using the Google form. (These scholarships would be the scholarships students have already been awarded; some will be surprise announcements that night!) Please complete no later than *Friday, April 26, 2024*.

Thank You Notes!

If you earned a private scholarship, please make sure you send a thank you note to thank the donor!

Caps & Gowns:

Students will pick up caps and gowns from Mrs. Bishop in the high school office. Pick up will be in April, specific date TBD.

Senior Online Students:

Please be sure to complete your online courses by *May 14th* in order to earn credit.

Early College Students:

Early College students participate in graduation events with the rest of their class. They should be sure to turn in their community service/job shadow logs to Mrs. Czymbor by May 10th. They will continue to work with Mrs. Czymbor in the 5th year, as needed, and EC students may pick up their diplomas next June 2025.

Final Transcripts:

Once final grades are posted in mid-June, be sure to request your final transcript to your college using Parchment. They will require these for financial aid and for course placement! Also, if you are dual enrolled, be sure to send your college transcript to your future college!

Home Directory & Email:

Students, be sure to save any important H drive files (resume, etc.) before your last day! Also, forward any important emails to your personal email address, and make sure you updated personal accounts using your personal email address!

Saturday School:
