# Important SENDOB Information

#### Thursday, May 9th: INTERFAITH BACCALAUREATE SERVICE

Held in the high school auditorium at 6:00 p.m. Students should wear graduation gowns. This is an optional event.

#### Thursday, May 9th: SENIOR HONORS NIGHT

Held in the high school gym at 7:00 p.m. Students will be invited if they have earned honors to be announced this evening, however all seniors are welcome to attend to support and cheer on their classmates! Students should wear graduation gowns.

### Wednesday, May 15: SENIOR EXIT INTERVIEWS

Seniors will be assigned a time to report to school to interview; the rest of the day, they are excused. Students should wear professional interview clothing.

### Thursday, May 16: SENIORS' LAST SCHOOL DAY

Be sure to take home all of your belongings. Once dismissed, students will not be allowed to reenter the building during the school day.

### Thursday, May 16: SENIOR SUNRISE & SENIOR CLAP OUT

Watch for details to follow.

### Friday, May 17: GRADUATION REHEARSAL

You must attend this mandatory rehearsal if you plan to participate in graduation! Plan ahead as you make appointments, begin your summer jobs, etc.! Please be sure to bring your cap & gown for rehearsal. Time to be announced, but it will be in the morning. Students MUST complete any Saturday School requirements in order to participate in the graduation ceremony.

### Sunday, May 19: GRADUATION CEREMONY

All seniors will meet in the auditorium at 1:30 p.m. Graduation begins at 2:00 p.m. All seniors MUST wear caps and gowns, and follow this suggested dress code: Gentlemen-Light colored shirt, dress pants, dress shoes and tie.

Ladies-Light colored dress or dress pants and light colored blouse and dress shoes. Students may invite as many guests to attend as they would like and no tickets are required.

#### Scholarships Announced on Honors Night:

(These scholarships would be the scholarships students have already been awarded; some will be surprise announcements that night!) Please complete no later than *Eriday, April 26, 2024.* 

#### Thank You Notes!:

If you earned a private scholarship, please make sure you send a thank you note to thank the donor!

#### Caps & Gowns:

Students will pick up caps and gowns from Mrs. Bishop in the high school office. Pick up will be in April, specific date TBD.

#### Senior Online Students:

Please be sure to complete your online courses by May 14th in order to earn credit.

### Early College Students:

Early College students participate in graduation events with the rest of their class. They should be sure to turn in their community service/job shadow logs to Mrs. Czymbor by May 10th. They will continue to work with Mrs. Czymbor in the 5th year, as needed, and EC students may pick up their diplomas next June 2025.

#### Final Transcripts:

Once final grades are posted in mid-June, be sure to request your final transcript to your college using Parchment. They will require these for financial aid and for course placement! Also, if you are dual enrolled, be sure to send your college transcript to your future college!

#### Home Directory & Email:

Students, be sure to save any important H drive files (resume, etc.) before your last day! Also, forward any important emails to your personal email address, and make sure you updated personal accounts using your personal email address!

#### Saturday School:

If you have been assigned Saturday School, you MUST have completed your required time in order to participate in the graduation ceremony!
