ABSENCES

Students are required to verify their absences with a note, an email or a telephone call from their parent/guardian. ARRIVING LATE/LEAVING EARLY

Students arriving to school late must report to the office to sign in. Students leaving school early for any reason must report to the office to sign out. Please notify Mrs. Bishop if your student will be leaving early, as the consent of a parent/guardian is required. Students are not allowed to leave campus for lunch. Students must never leave the campus without permission from the office. Students arriving to school after 10 minutes into ANY period will be marked absent for that period. Prior to the 10-minute mark, a tardy will be used. Students who leave 10 minutes before the end of any period will be marked absent for that period.

STUDENT DRIVERS

All students who will be driving a vehicle to school **MUST** obtain a parking permit for each vehicle that they will use. Permits are valid for the current school year only. All vehicles must be registered and must have a parking permit displayed in the front window. Students will be required to complete a Parking Permit Application and the application must be signed by their parent/guardian. Students will also be required to turn in a signed Student Parking Agreement. Upon receipt of the signed application and the signed agreement, the high school office will issue the parking permit(s) to the student. There is no cost for the permit. Forms are available in the high school office.

All students are required to park in the west student parking lot. No students are allowed to park in the east parking lot or in the Shop area. Vehicles are to be parked properly in the parking lot.

Students must adhere to the driving regulations listed in the student handbook. Students violating the parking/driving regulations may have their driving privileges revoked.

Calling 8th graders to become Shiawassee Scholars

Are you a parent or guardian of a high achieving 8th grader? The Shiawassee Regional Education Service District (SRESD) invites you and your child to attend an informational meeting about academically advanced opportunities. The meeting is hosted by the Shiawassee RESD on **Tuesday, October 3rd at 7:00 p.m.** at the SRESD Professional Building, 1025 N. Shiawassee St, Corunna 48817.

This meeting will include information on SAT testing, Shiawassee Scholars, and how to register for the SAT test. To apply to be a Shiawassee Scholar, the 8th grade student must take the SAT on or before December 2, 2023. An SAT testing opportunity will be held in December at Owosso Middle School.

The top 50 eighth grade students in the county, as determined by their scores on the SAT, will be invited to become Shiawassee Scholars! The Shiawassee Scholars is a collaborative program between the Shiawassee RESD and The Cook Family Foundation. The program seeks to recognize talented students early and encourage them to challenge themselves academically throughout their high school years. It is the mission of the Shiawassee Scholars program to support these students through various opportunities and resources to reach their full potential.

NEW INSTUCTIONS FOR EXITING THE PARKING LOT AFTER SCHOOL!




- Before 3:00 p.m., ALL HIGH SCHOOL TRAFFIC must exit via Championship Drive
